



Flu vaccine sessions will occur during weekdays in a designated clinic area.

1. Please [Book a flu vaccine appointment online](#).
2. Check in with one of our friendly car park receptionists when you arrive for your appointment. Please wear a mask at all times while onsite.
3. One of our doctors will give you your flu shot as close as possible to your appointment time.
4. We advise you to wait onsite about 10 minutes.

The flu clinics allow more of our patients to quickly receive their vaccine faster. We are generally unable to provide any other medical services during these Flu sessions. If you need additional medical advice, other vaccination advice, prescriptions or referrals, please see your usual GP.

Flu vaccines are at no cost from the Government for the following people:

- Anyone aged six months to younger than five years.
- Anyone aged 65 years and older.
- Pregnant women.
- Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islanders aged six months and older.
- Anyone aged six months and older with medical conditions that increases the risk of influenza disease complications (e.g. lung disease, heart disease, diabetes, immunosuppression, kidney disease, pregnancy).

For all other patients, the vaccine will cost \$20.

We will continue regular [COVID-19 vaccine](#) clinics on Saturday afternoons. Please be aware that there needs to be 14 days between your flu shot and any planned [COVID-19 vaccinations](#).

We can limit the impact of flu this winter by arranging for you and your family to be vaccinated as soon as possible.
